- Public research university
- Lincoln Campus Barkley Memorial Center
 - Doctoral (Au.D.) education program in audiology
 - >35 year history of coordinating statewide programs assisting low-income Deaf & Hard of Hearing individuals across the lifespan
 - Hearing Aid Banks of Nebraska

University of Nebraska

- University of Nebraska Omaha Campus
 - Social work program in Leon, Nicaragua
 - Could not identify those children who were Deaf or Hard of Hearing
 - Established a School for the Deaf
- Needs assessment conducted in 2014-2015 by UNL audiology faculty
 - No audiology services available in Leon

Leon, Nicaragua

- Second largest city with a population of ~206,000
- 50 miles northwest of Managua
- Political and intellectual center of the nation
- National Autonomous University of Nicaragua (UNAN)

 - Mayflower Medical Outreach
- Extensive conversations
 - Numerous emails & video chats
 - Common goals
 - Building/expanding capacity
 - Focus on sustainability

Initial In-Country Collaboration


- Arranged our initial trip to coordinate with MMO's mission trip
 - Two faculty from UNL & 4 Au.D. students
 - Worked with MMO in Jinotega clinic
 - Tremendously valuable: Model for our work in Leon
 - Met MMO in-country staff
 - Tested all students at the School for the Deaf and saw patients in a small village outside of Leon

Continued Collaboration

- Multiple trips (with MMO and separate)
 - Two faculty from UNL
 - Au.D. Students (4-6)
 - UNAN-Leon & School for the Deaf
 - Diagnostics and hearing aid fittings
 - Clinical training for two UNAN faculty members

Purpose of Meeting

- To discuss the feasibility of establishing the first university-based audiology training program in Nicaragua
 - Challenges were identified
 - MINSA
 - Funding
 - Training faculty members
 - Building the curriculum
 - Collectively, there was support to pursue this as a collaborative effort.

and then.....

- Political uprising April 2018
 - Very quick escalation
 - Travel warning level 3
 - Trips were postponed

New Challenges

- Follow-up with patients
- Growing waitlist
- Difficulty re-stocking supplies
- Pause in training of UNAN faculty
- Possible solution: Bring UNAN faculty to the United States



MOVING FORWARD

- University of Nebraska will host one UNAN faculty member for 4 months
- Priority: create a curriculum that UNAN can use to train health professionals within their college of medicine
 - This will be a collaborative effort between UNAN, MMO, and NU
 - NU faculty and students will travel to Leon midway through the 4 month period

Non-profit status in Nicaragua with established relationship with MINSA	People power – faculty & students
In-country staff/medical coordinator	Commitment to building a long-term relationship
Knowledge of available resources in Nicaragua	Connection to UNAN – Leon & School for the Deaf in Leon
Has a strong network including: Medical, Educational, and Hearing Services	Different perspectives – fresh ideas



Summary

- Perform a thorough needs assessment
- Do not reinvent the wheel
- Only begin if you're willing to fully invest for the long-term
- Create a strategic plan
- Revisit this plan often
- Sustainability should not be one of the goals, it should be the only goal!
